Whereas the first few of steps previously increased the volume by an average of 8 or 9 decibels, the volume increase in the first steps now averages closer to 5 decibels. For you this means that finding the perfect volume for any song is now much easier. And don't worry, this has no discernible impact on the max volume of ULTIMATE EARS BOOM; just in how you get there.
